GM report

Public input: J. Bartlett asked about the gravel line on Anderson Springs Rd. - this is from a leak repair. Water Master will get bids for repairing the road.

Old business: bylaws - Tabled.

175 project - we need to approve plans in order to get bids for the project. Brelje and Race consulting engineers gave us an estimate of \$6,000 to \$7,000 to do the design, consisting of one plan and profile drawing. Director Duke moved to approve the Brelje and Race estimate for the Highway 175 project design, Director Weber seconded, motion passed.

Surplus land - we are not considering selling right now.

Bank account signatures needed - all directors to meet at the bank next Friday at 5:00.

New business

Letter from the state was discussed. Merial Medrano, who was a previous general manager as well as on the ASCSD board for many years, has offered to look at our files and see where corrections may be indicated. The board accepts her offer.
